ABSTRACT

In Poland, 3 fish species, Atlantic sturgeon (*Acipenser sturio*), Atlantic salmon (*Salmo salar*) and huchen/Danube salmon (*Hucho hucho*), have become extinct, while four are included in the group of critically endangered (CE). As a result of successful restitution measures Atlantic salmon and huchen/Danube salmon have been successfully reintroduced. At present, the restitution of vimba (*Vimba vimba*) to the system of the Odra River, which was on the verge of extinction there, is attempted.
